CALL FOR SYMPOSIA

The 2012 biennial National Conference on Urban Entomology will be held in Marriott Perimeter Center, Atlanta, Georgia; May 20-23, 2012. The organizing committee invites proposals for conference symposia. There are opportunities for both 1.5 and 2.0 hour symposia.

Proposals should be as brief as possible and include the following:

1. A brief outline that indicates the symposium title, length (1.5 or 2.0 hours), and justification for inclusion at the NCUE.
2. A tentative list of speakers, presentation titles, and length of presentations.
3. Contact information for the organizer(s).

Symposia proposals should be submitted by May 18, 2011 to Grzegorz Buczkowski at gbuczkow@purdue.edu. The person submitting a proposal will be considered the symposium organizer. Symposia organizers are asked to ensure that the speakers have titles and abstracts sent in time for the program and that arrangements are made for someone to act as moderator. The organizing committee will complete the selection of symposia by May 23, 2011. Symposia organizers will be notified as soon as possible. The general call for papers for this meeting will be sent in October 2011.
