## **Position Announcement – Stored Product / Post Harvest Pest Management**

The Department of Entomology and Plant Pathology, Oklahoma State University, invites applications for an 11-month tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor with a work assignment of 70% research, 20% extension and 10% teaching. Applications are encouraged from individuals with training/interests in managing arthropod pests of stored products and/or post harvest. Preference will be given to candidates who have research experience in these areas and with interest in one or more of the following: IPM, toxicology, systematics, population and/or chemical ecology and whose research complements ongoing research and extension programs at Oklahoma State University. The successful candidate will be expected to develop an externally funded research program, to work with multi-disciplinary research and extension teams directed toward management of arthropods in post harvest situations and contribute to the Division's Stored Products Research and Extension Team. Teaching responsibilities may include one undergraduate/graduate course offered every other semester, and advisement of graduate students. Applicants must have an earned doctorate in entomology, or a closely related field. Postdoctoral experience in post harvest arthropod management research, development of extension programs and demonstration of the ability to obtain extramural funding are preferred. The successful candidate will have access to the Stored Products Research and Education Center located near campus consisting of laboratories, offices, conference room, replicated grain storage facilities and a research and maintenance staff for research /extension activities.

Applications should include the following: (1) letter of application stating reasons for interest in this position and qualifications, (2) curriculum vitae, (3) statement of research and extension education interests, (4) official university transcripts noting date of terminal (Ph.D.) degree, and (5) the names and contact information of four references. The Search and Screening Committee will begin review of applications September 30, 2007 and will continue reviews until a suitable candidate is selected. This information should be sent to:
